First Aid At Work

Duration: 3 Days

Who should attend?

This course is designed for those who need to become a registered First Aider and provides a valid certificate of competence in First Aid at Work for 3 years.

What does the course cover?

The course gives learners the knowledge and practical skills to provide immediate first aid where appropriate.

- Priorities of first aid including managing an incident
- Roles/responsibilities of employers & employees for first aid at work
- Care of the unconscious casualty
- Cardio pulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- Disorders of the airway
- Dealing with bleeding and shock, causes of unconsciousness
- Burns and scalds
- Injuries to bones, muscles & joints
- Poisoning
- Recognition and management of major illnesses, recognition of minor illnesses and appropriate action
- Eye injuries, miscellaneous injuries
- Record keeping and accident reporting
- Infection control
- Communication & delegation in an emergency
- Manage the transportation of a casualty

How is the course delivered?

The course is delivered as a mixture of lecture, discussion and practical application. There is a 40 minute multi-choice test at the conclusion of the course for those requiring certification

What are the benefits?

The benefits include ensuring your staff having the necessary certification to be a First Aider, and the experience to deal with a First Aid situation within your organisation.
