



DEGREES AND HIGHER EDUCATION

There are no upfront fees to be paid when taking advantage of a Government Loan, and repayments only start once you're earning over £21,000.

ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION DIPLOMAS

The government's Advanced Learner Loan could cover the costs of the Diploma. The remaining balance on this loan will be written off, once you go on to complete an eligible Higher Education course.

PROFESSIONAL AND ADULT LEARNER COURSES

Fees vary from course to course and can be found on our website, along with any assessment or registration costs. The government's Advanced Learner Loan could cover your costs, and there are lots of ways to receive free or discounted fees, for example if you are in receipt of certain benefits. As an Apprentice you will receive a salary from your employer which varies depending on the company and level of Apprenticeship. Remember – Higher Level Apprenticeships give you access to university-level qualifications without tuitions fees!

STUDENT FINANCE

This government loan is for students starting their first Degree or Higher Education course:

My friend is at university studying Nursing now, after doing the Access to Allied Health Professions course, and recommended it to me. I was unhappy in an office job, and wanted to do something about it, so I applied for the Access course here. It's been amazing - all the teachers are incredible, I can't give them enough praise. They're all really helpful, and always reply to any emails we send really quickly.

As a mature student, it's a happy environment here where no-one's segregated based on their age or background, and it's just a great place to study. The course prepares you for what it'll be like at university, on a small scale. I don't think many people know about Access - it's like A Levels but better - there aren't many exams, and a lot of us haven't done anything like this for years, so we do get help with our work.



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

FOR DEGREES AND HIGHER EDUCATION

Higher Education is an option for all. Our typical entry requirements are measured in terms of the UCAS Tariff, which is based on grades from post-16 qualifications, but we welcome students from all backgrounds to apply as we value the work and life experiences students bring to our courses.

DEGREES AND HIGHER EDUCATION

To apply for a full-time Degree or Higher Education course you can either complete an application through the University and College Admissions Service (UCAS) at www.ucas.com, or - if you are not applying to any other colleges or universities - via www.farn-ct.ac.uk/he.

University Centre Farnborough's UCAS code is F66. Our usual application deadline via UCAS is during the January before you wish to start, although it is possible to apply direct to us at any time.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

We welcome applications from international students with qualifications considered equivalent to our general entrance requirements. The process for applying for Degrees and Higher Education is the same as the full-time courses above. If English is not your first language, evidence of your ability will need to be supplied with your application; IELTS 6.5 is required.

PROFESSIONAL AND PART-TIME COURSES

Visit our website to make your application at www.farn-ct.ac.uk. Afterwards, you will be contacted with further information on the application process. For some subjects, this could include an invitation to an assessment or meeting with a course tutor, but attendance at an Enrolment Event is usually required to register you as a student.
