

GCSE Maths and English

- All students are given the opportunity to re sit their GCSE Maths and English if they haven't achieved a Grade 4
- The first re sit is in November intensive 6/7 week revision course
- Second opportunity is in the normal exam season in May/June
- Specialist English and Maths teaching staff with external speakers for motivational help
